READ INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE SETTING UP THE TENT

EASYUP BEACH TENT



Lay the beach tent flat with easy-up hub upright. Make sure poles are fully extended and spread out.




pull the two cords up and then away from each other.



Continue to pull the cords until the up per and lower sections of the hub connect. As the hubs get closer to connecting, the resistance will increase and the body of the tent will form. Once secure you will hear the easy-up hub "click" into place.



IMPORTANT! Once the easy-up hub is in place, tie the drawstring into a small bow. This will help to prevent the possibility of the tent accidentally collapsing.




For security and stability, stake down the corners of the shelter to secure in place. Sand pockets can be filled for additional stability.

SET UP

TAKE DOWN

WARNING: Stand back when taking down the tent. The hub can pop up quickly.



Untie the cords and separate the easy-up hub by pushing down on the lower hub poles. The poles are marked by sticker that say "PUSH DOWN HERE"



Gently lower down the entire easy-up tent.



Holding the easy-up hub upright, fold fabric and poles inward towards the hub.





- Fold the poles as shown
- Lay the tent on its side. Gather all poles tightly to the hub to prevent pole damage.
- 3. Bring all excess fabric together and roll tightly towards the easy-up hub (Similar to closing an umbrella)
- 4. Use provided strap to tightly tie the rolled tent
- 5. Place the tent in the storage bag for extended storage

CARE & STORAGE

- As Soon As Possible; Open your product and ensure that every area of fabric is clean and completely dry before rolling up for storage.
- If necessary, hang product outside or loosely drape over a ladder in your garage or spare room for a few days, turning it inside and out to prevent trapping pockets of water or debris.

 Use a soft brush to wine away surface dirt.

To clean your product: Hand wash using a mild dishwashing soap and soft bristle brush, then allow the fabric to completely air dry.

Don't neglect the frame: Wipe down all parts - steel, plastic, and fiberglass - before putting away for next season's use. Salts from ocean air can and do affect damage if not dealt with as quickly as possible.

Storing a wet fabric for as little as 24 hours in warm weather is likely to cause fabric to mildew. Once mildew sets in, the stains are permanent.
