

# BINGO SET

## TO WIN:

The object of the game is to cover a row of 5 numbers on a Bingo card in any direction – vertically, horizontally or diagonally. In order to win you must be the first to call out BINGO after a row of 5 numbers are covered.

## SETTING UP THE GAME:

- Separate all the cards and chip markers.
- Place all numbered balls into the Bingo cage.
- Turn the handle so the numbered balls are dispensed.
- Each player selects one or more Bingo cards and several chip markers. The square in the center is a free space and everyone starts with one chip covering this space.

## CHOOSE A BINGO CALLER:

- The Bingo Caller calls the number that is dispensed from Bingo cage.
- The Bingo Caller places the called number on the Master Board and checks the winning bingo card to see if it is correct.
- The caller can still play the game

## TO PLAY:

The Bingo Caller will turn the handle until a numbered ball is dispensed. The Bingo Caller will call the number on the ball. Example: Bingo Caller calls “B4” and all players that have B4 on their card will cover B4 with a chip marker.

## TO PLAY CONTINUED:

When a player has a row of 5 numbers covered either horizontal, vertical, or diagonal row, they call out Bingo. The Bingo Caller will check the bingo card to see if it is correct. If it's correct, the player calling bingo is the winner. If it is not correct, then the play continues until there is a winner. Please refer to diagram to reference the different configurations to win.



If two players call Bingo at the same time and they are both correct, then each player will get a new number from the Bingo cage and the highest number wins.

After each game, a new Bingo Caller is chosen and the cards may be exchanged for new ones or you can keep the one you have.
